### Important reminders and updates

- **Friday, June 9, 2023 – Deadline for Team Captains making on-line changes**  
Team Captains can make changes to riders and legs online up to and including this date by logging onto the Karelo registration platform with their user ID and password.  
If you've forgotten your password, use the Forgot Password mechanism on the [www.karelo.com](http://www.karelo.com) website.  
If you are having difficulty making changes, please email [Mike@kcibr.org](mailto:Mike@kcibr.org) before June 9, 2023. If you are adding riders (e.g. you registered 5 riders on your 8-person team and you now want to add more riders), you will need to send an email. If emailing, please include your Karelo team registration #. Any changes after this date can only be made at package pick-ups and will involve change fees. You CANNOT make changes after you pick up your race package.

  - \* Haines Junction: Friday June 16 from 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM  
St. Elias Convention Centre
- In place of the Captain's Meetings, all riders **MUST** view the **Racer Briefing video**. The link will be posted on the website and emailed to all participants in early June.
- **WAIVERS** - A team representative must bring a **completed and signed waiver for each member of their team in order to pick up their race package** on the Tuesday (Whitehorse) or Friday (Haines Junction) night prior to the event. Download a waiver from the KCIBR Registration page (found at the bottom of the page). We have also attached it in this email.  
Please do NOT email waivers. We require hard copies for our records.
- A Race Information Package will be emailed to all riders soon. Be sure to share any applicable information with your support crews.
- For those with children - don't forget: Sunday June 18 from 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM Alaska Time 5th Annual Free **Kids' Fishing Derby** for those under 15 at the Haines docks. Catch and release. Sponsored by Haines Hotshots.
- Please ride and drive safely. Obey all traffic rules and be aware of your surroundings. Traffic volume is increasing, with the summer tourist season fast approaching. Do not ride side by side on a public road.
